Topic: Nitrogen Pollution and Sinkholes

Dr. Ming Ye is an Associate Professor in the Department of Scientific Computing and an Associate of the Geophysical Fluid Dynamics Institute at the Florida State University (FSU). His research areas are groundwater flow and reactive transport modeling, computational uncertainty analysis, applied geostatistics, and sinkhole study. He has developed an ArcGIS-based software for estimating nitrogen load from septic tanks to surface water bodies, and the software is free to the public. His laboratory research on sinkhole development and collapse has been recently reported in the PBS/NOVA program entitled "Sinkholes: Buried Alive".
