**APWA Big Bend Branch - 2018 Equipment Road-E-O Release,
Indemnity and Hold Harmless Agreement**

The undersigned _____ (Operators Name) acknowledges that the following terms are a condition to his participation in the 2018 APWA Equipment Road-E-O, and hereby agrees that:

1. Operator acknowledges that construction equipment of the type used in the “Road-E-O” is a dangerous instrumentality and can cause serious bodily injury, death, and damage to property if not used in a safe and careful manner by trained and experienced operators. Operator warrants and represents to any participating Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park that he has been fully and adequately trained in the use of any and all equipment which he operates in the Road-E-O and that he has had actual experience with the equipment. Operator further warrants and represents that he possesses the skill to operate and use any such equipment in a safe and careful manner and agrees to so operate such equipment as to avoid any and all damage to property or injury to persons. Operator acknowledges that Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park is relying upon this representation and warranty.
2. Operator shall indemnify and hold Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park harmless from the claims of any and all persons for death, bodily injury, or damage to property which arises as a result of Operator’s participation, use and operation of equipment in the Road-E-O, whether such claims are based in whole or in part upon the negligence of Operator, the negligence of Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park, any defect in equipment, any site condition, or any negligence by any other person, including other Operators.
3. Operator agrees that, as an essential term and condition to his participation in the Road-E-O, he hereby acquits, discharges, exonerates and forever releases Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park, their officers, directors, employees, agents, successors and assigns, of and from any and all actions, causes of action, damages, liability, obligations, rights, torts, wrongs and claims (Claims) which may arise from Operator’s use of equipment in the Road-E-O, including any and all claims of any nature whatsoever, whether for death, bodily injury and/or damage to property, whether the Claims are due in whole or in part to any fault or negligence by or attributable to Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park, any failure or defect in any equipment or otherwise. As an inducement to Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park, to allow Operator to participate in the Road-E-O, Operator agrees, for himself, his heirs, successors and assigns, that he shall not sue or make any Claim of any kind against Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park, their officers, directors, employees, agents, successors and assigns, for or in account of anything which may relate to or arise from the Road-E-O.
4. Operator consents to and authorizes the APWA Big Bend Branch and Equipment Dealers to use any photograph, video, film, or depiction of Operator for advertising and other commercial purposes; Operator waives and releases any participating Equipment Dealer, APWA, the APWA Big Bend Branch, City of Tallahassee, Leon County, and Tom Brown Park, from any right to compensation for the use of Operator’s likeness pursuant to Section 540.08, Florida Statutes or as may otherwise be provided by law.
5. Operator affirms he possesses a valid State of Florida Driver’s License.

2018 Annual APWA ROAD-E-O GENERAL RULES

This event is organized to recognize professional skills and to interact with other public works disciplines. It is also an opportunity to explore and admire the abilities of individuals and promote teamwork in an atmosphere that also allows a little fun. As with any competition, some general rules are needed to clarify and provide guidance. Listed below are general rules of understanding:

CHECK-IN

1. All attendees and guests included must check in & confirm/receive identification tags. Identification tags must be worn at all times.

TEAM

1. A team shall consist of a minimum of 4 contestants with a maximum of 10.
2. Each team shall try to have **at least one (1) APWA Big Bend Branch member**.
3. Each team member must submit an indemnity form with the team application.
4. The team members cannot vary from the submitted entry form. However, if an alternate team member is listed on the entry form, that individual may replace a team member who is sick or otherwise unable to compete.
5. The team captain shall be chosen from the list of event competitors.
6. Any team application received after 5:00 p.m. on May 18, 2018 will be disqualified.
7. Any incomplete/incorrect applications must be resubmitted within 24 hours of notification in order to qualify for competition.

SAFETY

1. Observers are prohibited from the designated restricted areas.
2. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

FOOD

1. Lunch will be provided for all sponsors, contestants, judges and individuals providing event assistance. There also will be a Raffle. Tickets will be \$1.00 each, or 6 for \$5.00.

SCORING

1. Judges' decisions, in each event, are deemed final.
2. Each team that does not compete in an event will be assessed the last place score for that particular event.
